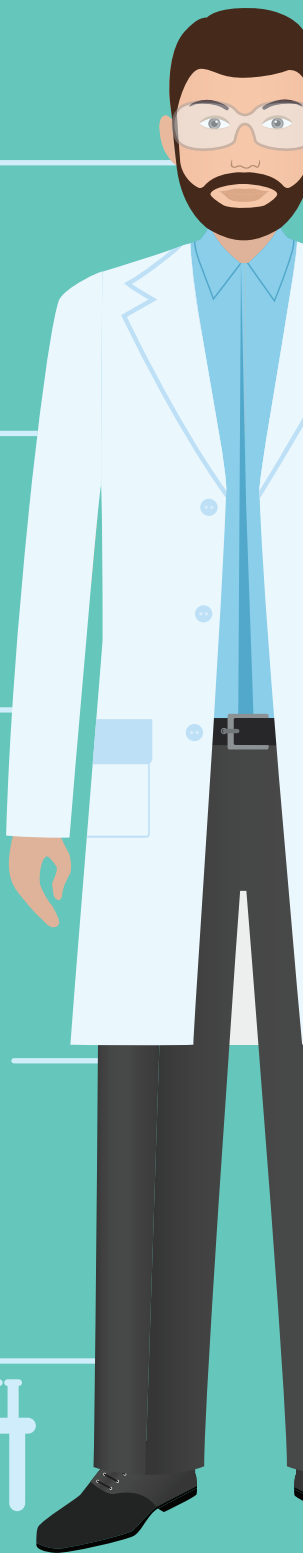
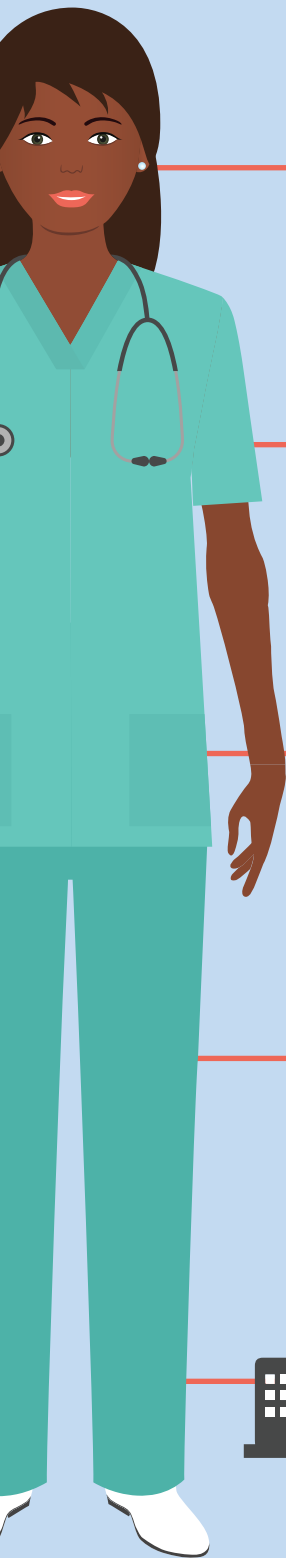

WORK ENVIRONMENT



RN's work in hospitals, physicians' offices, home healthcare services, and nursing care facilities. They are in close contact with people and may spend a lot of time on their feet.
